In Mosiah 8 Ammon is teaching the people of Limhi. He teaches them about a seer. King Limhi wanted to know if Ammon could translate the 24 golden plates (v. 9-11) Ammon teaches the king that a man can translate the records is known as a seer. That it is a gift from God (v. 13). In verse 16 Ammon said that “a seer is a revelator and a prophet also.” In verse 17 it teaches us that “a seer can know of things which are past, and...which are to come”

For the activity we are going to translate some things.




A seer can only translate through the gift and power of God. Today we are going to translate with the help of a cipher known as a pigpen cipher.


